The following examples are but a few samples of the detailed instructions given by God.

Match the rituals on the right to the correct descriptions on the left.

Special Sin Offering

Ram without defect

- To be slaughtered
- Its blood to be sprinkled against the altar on all sides
- To be cut and washed
- Whole ram with head to be burnt on the altar



Special Burnt Offering

Ram without defect

- To be slaughtered
- Some of its blood to be put on the right ear lobes of Aaron and his sons, the thumbs of their right hands and big toes of their right feet.
- Some blood and anointing oil from the altar are to be sprinkled on Aaron and his sons' garment
- Parts of it and an unleavened loaf to be used as a wave offering
- Parts of it to be eaten by Aaron and his sons



Ram of Ordination

Bull without defect:

- To be slaughtered at the entrance to the Tent of Meeting
- Its blood to be poured out, with some to be put on the horns of the altar
- Innards & Fats to be burnt on altar
- Flesh and hide to be burnt outside camp.
- One bull to be used every day for 7 days
